

CSM Judith C. Macy

Command Sergeant Major of the National Guard Patriot Academy

Command Sergeant Major Judy Macy was sworn in as the first Command Sergeant Major of the National Guard Patriot Academy on April 15, 2009. She serves as the commandant's advisor on enlisted personnel matters.

CSM Macy enlisted into the Army on March 31, 1982 and was stationed in New Ulm Germany for six years as a telephone installer. In 1988, she returned to the states and transferred to the Army Reserves where she served in numerous leadership positions at Camp Atterbury, Indiana and later served with Army TRADOC as course manager for a wire installer course in Kings Mill, Ohio and later at Ft. Indiantown Gap, Pennsylvania.

In 1995, she served as the Telecommunications Operations NCOIC for the 123rd Army Reserve Command in Indianapolis, Indiana at Ft. Benjamin Harrison. CSM Macy transferred to the Indiana Army National Guard in 1996 as the Operations NCOIC for the 38th Infantry Division DISCOM and was selected first sergeant after two months. In 1998, she was selected as the HHC 38th ID 1SG and subsequently as the G2 sergeant major for the 38th ID.

CSM Macy became the first female CSM in the INARNG when she was selected to serve as the CSM for the 138th Signal Battalion. Before retiring from the INARNG in 2004, her last assignment was CSM for the 81st Troop Command. She was called out of retirement in the spring of 2009, where she was selected to serve as CSM of the National Guard Patriot Academy.

CSM Macy graduated Magna Cum Laude with a B.S. degree in Management from the Indiana Wesleyan University. Her accomplishments include being selected as Honor Graduate at the U.S. Army Sergeants Major Academy at Ft. Bliss, Texas, Vice President for First Franklin, Merrill Lynch Mortgages Division and received salesperson of the year award for top sales production in 1999 & 2005 and top branch manager for operations and sales in 2006.

Her significant awards and decorations include the Legion of Merit, Meritorious Service Medal with Two Oak Leaf Clusters, Army Commendation Medal with Two Oak Leaf Clusters, and Army Achievement Medal with Four Oak Leaf Clusters.

She is married to CSM (Ret.) William Macy. They have 4 children and 12 grandchildren.
